

Castle level two

Students will go to several sites such as

1. Create a story of a boy/girl who is lost in the castle and must find their way to the Main Hall for a ceremony (you may choose what the ceremony is). You must include the following terms in your story, in context:

Murder holes, moat, donjon or keep, great hall, great chamber, drawbridge, gate house, dungeon, garderobe, turret, wicket, bailey, postern gate, barbican, chapel

2. Underline the terms in red as you use them. Check them off on your directions. You may not use more than ONE term in each sentence. Your story should have elements that show the reader the story takes place in Medieval times (example – clothes).
3. The story needs to be typed, double spaced, 14 size font, New Times Roman. You must design an appropriate cover page with title, color, heading.
