BRONZE: Students will write a letter about their city-state to share with their classmates. The letter should be from their perspective as if they really are from that city-state. You will address the letter to another city-state. Students will include information about:

SILVER: Students will create a persuasive speech to convince people to move to your city-state. Remember you need to make your city-state sound better than the others. Students will include the following information:
