French & Italian Lords	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To take the city of Jerusalem from the Muslims after reports of pilgrims robbed/tortured there. • The pope wanted the knights to stop fighting among themselves and join this cause. • To help out the Byzantine emperor who feared invasion from the Turks. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Killed 70,000 men, women, and soldiers in Jerusalem • Crusade that was able to capture Jerusalem. • Crusades set up 4 feudal colonies in the Holy Land by Christians
2.	Louis VII & Conrad III	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recapture Jerusalem after h Turks won back their lost land. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crusade lost at Damascus and returned home in disgrace

3.	Richard, Fredrick, Phillip II	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Second attempt to take the Turks, hold on Jerusalem. • Leaders: Richard, Phillip, Frederick 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Richard/Saladin sign a truce • Allow Christian pilgrims to visit shrines in Holy Land
4.	French Knights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To capture Constantinople then to take the Holy Lands 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crusaders never got Holy Land attacked Constantinople instead
Children	Youths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The youngest group trying to take the holy lands. 	Youth never made it- sent home or sold into slavery on Med. Sea Coast
