Archaeology: *The study of human history and prehistory through the excavation of sites and the analysis of artifacts.*

Anthropology: *The study of humankind, and human culture.*

Similarities between the two:

- Both ask questions and test their conclusion against new evidence.
- Both study the past and present.

Differences between the two:

- Archaeology focuses on finding and studying artifacts.
- Anthropologist study artifacts, beliefs, and values of a culture to learn more about a culture.
