



Top Ten List on Your Roman Ruler





<u>Step three</u> – Rank them from ten to one. Ten being least important to one being most important. Ten should be at the top and one at the bottom of the page.

Step four – Create a visual to display your information –(examples decorated poster, power point, song or rap that is presented with a hard copy of lyrics for teacher, dress as the ruler with a scroll and proclaim your 10 facts, puppet show.) YOU MAY NOT JUST WRITE OR TYPE THE 10 FACTS ON A PIECE OF PAPER AND GLUE IT TO POSTER BOARD. If you have an another idea, please clear it with your teacher before Dec 3nd. YOU MUST CHECK PART OF YOUR POWER POINT WORKS ON THE CLASSROOM COMPUTER BY DECEMBER 10. SAVE ON STUDENT SHARE, FLASHDRIVE, or Google.doc ONLY

<u>Step five</u> – **Bring your completed visual to school on Dec 17th(Monday) – no exceptions.** If you are leaving early on vacation you must present this before you go. If you are absent the day or two before it is still due on the due date. You may bring the project down to the classroom when you come to school in the morning.

Top Ten List on Your Roman Ruler

<u>Step one</u> – Research the accomplishments of your ruler to Rome.

Step two – Choose 10 pieces of information that we should remember about your ruler.
Events before he was emperor must directly relate to his choice. Birth and death dates not relevant unless they had an untimely death or Parents were of some importance.

<u>Step three</u> – Rank them from ten to one. Ten being least important to one being most Important. Ten should be at the top and one at the bottom of the page.

Step four – Create a visual to display your information –(examples decorated poster, power point, song or rap that is presented with a hard copy of lyrics for teacher, dress as the ruler with a scroll and proclaim your 10 facts, puppet show.)
